While the current CVS location at 4895 Dundas Street West in Etobicoke has served us very well over the years, it became clear that we've outgrown the space. After careful consideration we decided not to renew our lease and Community Living Toronto will officially exit the current CVS location on **June 30, 2024**.

We will be offering Creative Village Studio (CVS) classes such as painting, knitting, cooking, card making, Zumba and music at our **Community Junction location at 2934 Dundas Street West**.

Community Junction is a dynamic hub for artistic expression and will be the first satellite location to offer CVS programming. The space will bring together artists to hone and showcase their talents. While the location of CVS is changing, the positive impact will live on, fostering a sense of unity and pride within the wider community.

The CVS team members and instructors will be working out of Community Junction alongside an expanded team of colleagues and people we support. You can expect high quality programming in a supportive space for artists with varying abilities.
